## 1. Grad Gown Care

**Grad gowns will be handed out in the Multi on Wed, June 12 and Thurs, June 13**

The Gown: Remove your gown immediately and place on a hanger. Use a COOL iron if needed to remove any wrinkles. Further instructions are on the back of the gown package.

**\*\*No alterations to gown or stole will be permitted\*\***

## 2. Grad Convocation Rehearsal - Friday June 21, 2019 (Mandatory)

Time: 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm

Location: Evangel Church - 3261 Gordon Drive Kelowna

All graduating students are **required** to be at the ceremony rehearsal on June 21 from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm. You must bring your gown and stole to the rehearsal. Please make sure that your name is clearly labelled on each item (masking tape or sticky label). Please bring the gown on a hanger.

**Grad caps will be handed out the day of the ceremony.**

### **3. Grad Convocation Ceremony - Saturday June 22, 2019**

Graduating students will be bussed from the Garden Party to Evangel Church. Students will arrive at the church by 1:00 pm. There is no set limit for the number of guests, but we do ask that people are mindful that this is a large grad class. Seating is on a first come first served basis. The ceremony will begin promptly at 2:00 pm and will last for approximately 2.5 - 3 hours. Please note that the Evangel Church can become quite warm when it is full of people.

1:00 pm - students arrive at Evangel Church

2:00 pm - Grad ceremonies begin (ceremonies run approx. 3 hours)

6:30 pm - Students meet back at OKM to board the busses for Dry Grad activities.

OKM is very proud of our 2019 Graduates, and we look forward to honoring this occasion at our Convocation ceremony. During the ceremony some of the students will be receiving their Dogwood certificate along with their graduation certificate, if they met the grad requirements early. The Ministry of Education will send all other Dogwood certificates to the school in August. Please make a note to come to the school the last week of August to pick them up.

# StudentTranscripts Service

## Information For Students

**StudentTranscripts Service (STS)** is an online application for students to view their school marks, transcripts, scholarships and send transcripts electronically to post secondary institutions and employers.



### Get Started

To register for STS students will need:

- Personal Education Number (PEN)
- Full legal name
- Date of birth
- Email address

**Step 1** Go to the Ministry of Education's **Transcripts and Certificate website** at <http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca>.

**Step 2** You **must sign up** for a BCeID before you can use the StudentTranscripts Service. For BCeID signup, you need to:

- Complete the fields to register for a basic BCeID
- Select your password reset questions and answers (**remember these** as you will need them if you forget your password)
- Follow the system prompts and sign up for StudentTranscripts Service.

**Step 3** Log-in to StudentTranscripts Service using your BCeID.

When registering for the Student Transcript Service using your BCeID, you will be prompted to:

- Enter your student information used by your school (see **Get Started** information above)
- Read the personal data collection info and complete the process by clicking "submit"
- An email will be sent to the email address provided and must be activated within 24 hours of receipt or you will need to complete the registration process again
- Once activated, you will be able to log onto STS using your BCeID and password.

**Step 4** From your STS Dashboard, you can choose your post-secondary institutions (PSIs) selections, preview, send and order transcripts, view exam and assessment results and view scholarship information. Please note that all transcripts previewed in the STS are considered unofficial, but official transcripts will be sent out when ordered.

You will need to consent to the STS privacy notice which enables the ministry to send your transcripts to your selected PSIs by paper or electronically depending on how the PSI is able to receive transcripts. Printed copies of transcripts may take up to 3 weeks for processing and delivery to your selected PSIs.
