## The Application Process- How do you secure a spot?

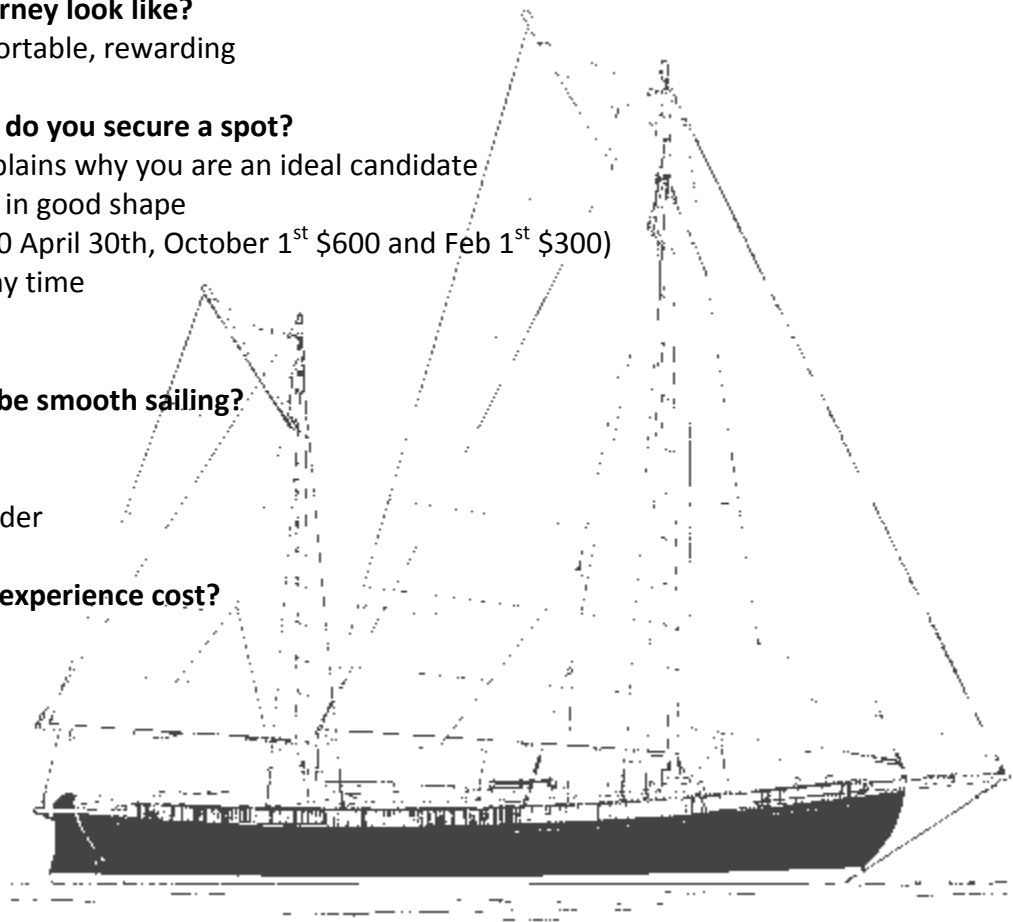
Submit one paragraph that explains why you are an ideal candidate
